The total amount of bonds, excluding refunding bonds and any bonds or any portion of bonds issued that are payable solely from revenues received or expected to be received under a contract with a governmental entity, approved by the voters and that has been or may be issued, at this date, is \$92,257,640 for water, sanitary sewage, drainage and storm sewer, organization and administration purposes; \$28,227,790 for road purposes; and \$5,150,000 for implementation of a Joint Fire Protection Plan; and the aggregate initial principal amount of all bonds issued for one or more of the specified facilities of the District and payable in whole or in part from property taxes is \$21,010,000.

The District also has the authority to adopt and impose a standby fee on property in the District that has water, sanitary sewer, or drainage facilities and services available but not connected and which does not have a house, building or other improvement located thereon and does not substantially utilize the utility capacity available to the property. The District may exercise the authority without holding an election on the matter. As of this date, the most recent amount of the standby fee is \$0.00. An unpaid standby fee is a personal obligation of the person that owned the property at the time of imposition and is secured by a lien on the property. Any person may request a certificate from the District stating the amount, if any, of unpaid standby fees on a tract of property in the District.

The district is located within the exterritorial jurisdiction of the City of Boerne. By law, a district located in the extraterritorial jurisdiction of a municipality may be annexed without the consent of a district or the voters in the District. When a district is annexed, it is dissolved.

The purpose of this District is to provide water, sewer, drainage or flood control facilities, roads and services within the District through the issuance of bonds payable in whole or
