## Ornamental Trees ✨

Planting ornamental trees like the Yaupon Holly or Mountain Laurel is a beautiful way to organically create privacy. Choosing a rugged and reliable evergreen tree such as the Blue Ice Arizona Cypress for large-scale screening and windbreaks is a smart choice as well.



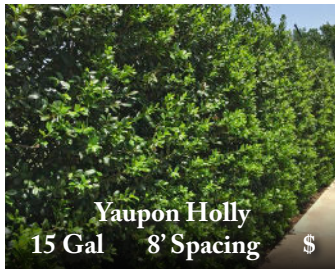

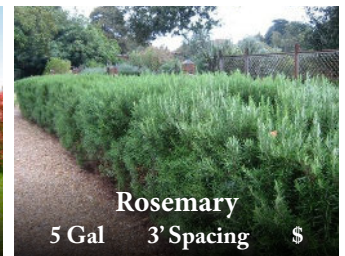

Mix and match plant types so that you can extend beyond the height of your existing fence and create a landscape of ever-changing colors and foliage.

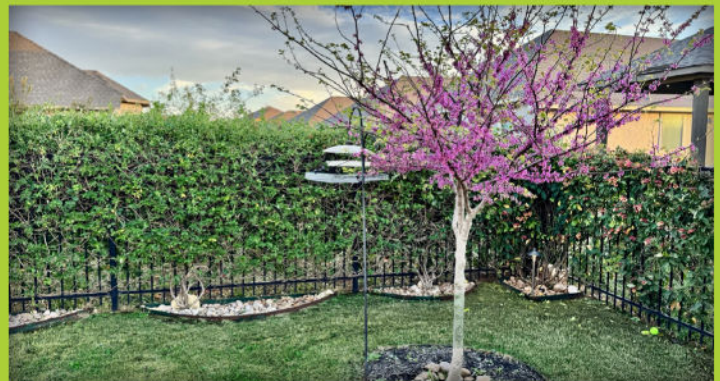
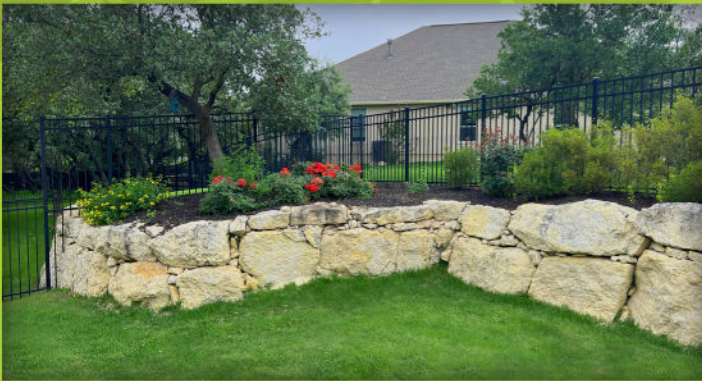
